### What to Do if Your Child is Absent

- **Contact Us on the First Day of Absence**

Please inform the school **before 9:00am** if your child is unable to attend.

- **Provide a Reason for the Absence**

Clearly state your child's full name, year group, and the reason for their absence.

- **Daily Updates**

If your child is absent for more than one day, please contact the school each morning unless a medical note has been provided.

### Authorised and Unauthorised Absence

- **Medical Appointments**

Where possible, arrange medical or dental appointments outside of school hours. If unavoidable, please provide a copy of the appointment card, letter, or confirmation. Absences can only be authorised with evidence.

- **Holidays During Term Time**

Holidays should not be taken during school time.

If there are exceptional circumstances, a **Holiday Request Form** must be completed in advance. Approval is at the discretion of the Headteacher and will only be granted in line with government guidelines.

## **Government Legislation – Children Missing Education**

The government requires all schools to monitor attendance carefully. Persistent or unexplained absence may be treated as a safeguarding concern.

- Local Authorities must be notified of any child who is missing from education.
  - Parents have a legal duty to ensure their child attends school regularly.
  - Unauthorised absences may lead to further action, including involvement from the Local Authority.
